By virtue of this Agreement, Mr/Ms....., holder of National Id Document number....., acting for and on behalf of, with contact telephone number and email address, HIRES the Spanish Reproduction Rights Centre (hereinafter referred to as “CEDRO”) to undertake the Right Holder Search and Localisation Service (annex attached).

CEDRO shall search for the right holders under this Agreement during the period of time required or deemed appropriate. CEDRO shall periodically notify the Right Holder Search and Localisation Service requester of the status of the corresponding searches so that he or she may decide on the continuance of the service.

On finding the right holders, CEDRO, where appropriate, shall request authorisation to share their contact details with the user of the service under this Agreement. CEDRO shall not, under any circumstance, share the contact details of right holders without the required prior authorisation.

The user engaging the service authorises CEDRO to provide right holders with information relating to the user and the reason for the search, which may include person data. In the event that the localisation service finalises with CEDRO sending a right holder a request on behalf of the requester, it shall be understood, for the purpose of invoicing, that the holder has been found.

The signing of this Agreement, for the provision of the abovementioned service, implies complete acceptance of the conditions set out.

On engaging the service, an invoice under the reference of Right Holder Search and Localisation Service shall be issued to the sum of €30.00 plus VAT for each holder to find (a 15% discount will be applied for members).

This Agreement shall not be valid without the prior payment of said amount.

Pursuant to the provisions under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council dated 27 April 2016 (GDPR), the data of the requester shall be incorporated into a file belonging to CEDRO, which it shall use to manage and maintain the contractual relationship between the Parties.

The data that you give us are required to provide the service. Should such data not be given, it will not be possible to provide such service.

The personal data shall be blocked when they are no longer required for the purpose for which they were collected. They shall be exclusively available to judges, courts and tribunals, the public prosecution service and the competent public authorities until any liability arising from such processing has expired. On expiry of said period, CEDRO shall erase said data.

Furthermore, CEDRO informs the requester that he or she may exercise at any time his or her right to access, rectification, erasure, portability, restriction or objection as regards such personal data by sending notification thereof to CEDRO at C/ Alcalá, 26, 3º (entrada C/ Cedaceros, 1), 28014, Madrid. A copy of the requester's National Id Document or passport must be attached to said notification. The requester may also submit a complaint to the Spanish Data Protection Agency in the event that he or she considers that the processing fails to comply with current legislation.
